## Sutter Park Preschool to Break Ground on Inclusive Playground

POWELL, OHIO – Sutter Park PTA and Sutter Park Preschool will break ground this week on an inclusive playground. Possibility Playground began as a PTA fundraising dream and will soon become a reality thanks to a collaboration with the Worthington City School District and Sutter Park Preschool. The Sutter Park PTA is inviting the community to a groundbreaking ceremony at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 12 at Sutter Park Preschool, 1850 Sutter Parkway, Powell, Ohio.

This occasion will commemorate the start of construction on the accessible playground designed for children ages three to six years old. PlayWorld Midstates has been selected for construction of the park facilities that will include a trike track, adaptive swings, an Aeroglider™, Accessible Whirl and a Quattro Seesaw.

Each piece of equipment was carefully selected by a group of school therapists, staff and parents to create an outdoor learning environment for the students at Sutter Park Preschool.

The celebration will include a brief ceremony, followed by ice cream treats courtesy of Worthington Dairy Queen and music by Sound Skyline & Gill Edutainment. Speakers at the event include Sutter Park Preschool Principal Tricia Hosking and Sutter Park PTA President Abigail Brown.

When complete in August, the playground will feature poured-in-place safety surfacing, more than ten pieces of special equipment and three different slides on over 8,500 square feet of play space.
